Sport Horse in Hand classes must be received by May 10, 2017 for scheduling purposes. Additional entries may be accepted, contact Annette Wells [serrerr@aol.com](mailto:serrerr@aol.com). ## ENTRY INFORMATION

- Entries MUST be submitted on the Official Entry Form for this show. If additional forms are needed, please make a request or make copies of **both sides** of the form.
- The Show Program will reproduce the entry information as it appears on the entry form. Illegible or omitted information will NOT appear in the program.
- Complete name and address of Registered Owner MUST appear in space for Owner Information. ONE OWNER ONLY per form. If a horse(s) is owned by a farm or any other entity, only one principal owner of the farm or entity needs to be a member and pay respective non-member registration fee. (To be eligible for Horse of the Year Awards, a farm or any other entity that owns a horse(s) must also obtain an exhibitor registration pursuant to GR816). AHA also requires the farm/trust must have an AHA Business Membership and that the Business membership number must be used as the Owner AHA number. A copy of the Business membership card must accompany the entry.
- Owner, Trainer, Rider, Coach MUST SIGN the entry form in the spaces provided. If Owner, Trainer, Rider, Coach ARE THE SAME, OWNER MUST SIGN IN BOTH PLACES. Junior exhibitors are not eligible to sign the entry blank.
- No horses may be entered on more than one entry form. **PLEASE NOTE:**

**Entry blanks allow only one horse per form.**

- INCLUDE PHOTOCOPIES OF REGISTRATION PAPERS INCLUDING THE PEDIGREE PORTION OF EACH HORSE ENTERED. Arabian Horses – Horses shown in this division must have been issued a certificate of registration from the Arabian Horse Registry of America, Inc. and/or Canadian Arabian Horse Registry. Half-Arabian Horses & Anglo-Arabian Horses – Horses shown in this division must have a certificate of registration from the Arabian Horse Association in the Half-Arabian or Anglo-Arabian Registry or have been issued an Arabian Horse Association (Canadian Part bred Arabian Registry) CPAR PERMIT.
- INCLUDE PHOTOCOPIES OF CURRENT AHA COMPETITION MEMBER CARDS FOR EVERY OWNER, TRAINER, RIDER, HANDLER, DRIVER AND JUNIOR OWNER & RIDER. If the above cards are NOT submitted, appropriate fees MUST be paid. \*\*Proof of AHA Competition membership may be your CURRENT AHA CARD. COMPETITION AFFIDAVITS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. Any owner, trainer, driver, rider, halter handler or person under age of 19 as of December 1st of the previous year, who exhibits horses in the show ring or signs the entry form as the responsible person for any individual's horses at the show, must be a competition member of AHA, or pay an additional fee of \$35 per person.
- Include PHOTOCOPIES of CURRENT USEF MEMBER CARDS FOR EVERY OWNER, TRAINER, RIDER, HANDLER, DRIVER, COACH AND JUNIOR OWNER & RIDER. If you do not possess a current membership card, you MUST pay the appropriate SHOW PASS fees (exception: Adult Amateurs MUST be USEF members). USEF Amateur Status must appear in appropriate place on USEF card for Adult Amateur.
- Enclose a Valid Check or Money Order. **\*\*\*ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED OR PROCESSED UNLESS ACCOMPANIED WITH TOTAL AMOUNT DUES FOR ENTRIES.**

**BREEDING IN HAND CLASSES/CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES** – All Breeding/In-Hand Halter Classes will be run using the Comparative Judging System. The Class Procedure for Comparative Judging is outlined in the AHA Handbook Comp 815. This information will also be posted in the horse show office.

**POST ENTRY DEADLINE** – For horses already entered in the show, post entries will be accepted up to 1 hour prior to the class, except in Dressage and Sport Horse in Hand. Post entries in dressage must be approved by the Dressage Manager, Annette Wells. New horses must be entered 4 hours prior to the class. Scratches or handler changes in Sport Horse In Hand classes MUST be made in the show office no later than 5:00pm Saturday, May 20th. A fee of \$10 will be charged for non-notification of a scratched class or rider/handler change.

**DOGS AND PETS** – The state humane officer requires all dogs to be leashed AT ALL TIMES. This rule will be strictly enforced. Owner assumes all liability for pet animals.

**DRESSAGE** – Dressage classes may not run in the order or the day listed. All riders must wear protective headgear (USEF DR120.6).

**FARRIER** – A farrier will be available on the grounds during show hours.

**FIRE REGULATIONS PROHIBIT PARKING BETWEEN THE BARNs** – As soon as you unload your horse, please move your vehicle to a designated parking area. Parking in the barn area is prohibited. Vehicles in "No Parking" areas will be towed at the owner's expense. Access to the barn area during the show hours will be limited. Specific areas have been set aside for parking horse trailers and vans for exhibitors showing from the trailer. Trailers may be moved by Brookside Management if not parked properly.

**FIRST AID** – There will be an EMT on the grounds during show hours.

**FOOTING** – There is sand footing in all arenas and warm-up rings. Ring dimensions are as follows: Main Arena – 275' x 150', Arena #2 – 240' x 150' and Grand Prix Arena – 150' x 240'. The warm-up arenas are 200' x 150'.

**REFUNDS** – To encourage early entries, the management agrees to cancel and refund entry and stall fees on any horse not fit to show providing written notice is given to the Show Secretary on or before May 17, 2016. Requests received between May 19 and May 22, 2016 show management will consider refunds due to illness, injury or accidents. All requests must be in writing, accompanied by a Veterinarian Certificate, and must be received by the Show Secretary prior to the start of the show. On approved refunds, all class fees will be refunded. Refunds for stalls, tack rooms or resolution fees will be on a case by case basis. Any refunds will be made by mail, approximately one month after the show.

**RV OVERNIGHT** – Limited RV hook-ups (15AMP) are available on reservation only. RV spaces must be reserved. Any rig plugged into an electrical hook-up will be considered an RV. There is a flat fee of \$150 for the entire show. Very

limited electrical power is available especially on very hot days. It has improved though. Please bring your own generator just in case it is needed. Electrical improvements have been made in the last year through Brookside Barns & RV hook-ups. **PLEASE NOTE:** Brookside will now be in charge of all RV reservations, collection of payment and placement of RVs. Please call (916) 682-1403 to make your reservations now.

**SHOW OFFICE AND REGISTRATION** – Registration at the Horse Show Office by the exhibitor is required upon arrival at the show grounds. The show office will be open 1:00 PM on Tuesday May 16 and daily one hour prior to the start of the first class each day of the show. The office will be closed for lunch and dinner. It will close after the last class of each day except Sunday when the office will stay open 1 hour after the last class. **AN OPEN CHECK OR CREDIT CARD WILL BE REQUIRED FROM ALL EXHIBITORS IN ORDER TO PICK UP BACK NUMBER PACKETS.**

**STABLING ASSIGNMENTS – NO STALLS WILL BE RESERVED WITHOUT PRE-PAYMENT IN FULL** – Assignment of stalls is entirely at the discretion of the Barn & Show Manager. Horses must be placed in stalls assigned and no changes will be permitted without the express consent of the Barn Manager. Assignments will be made as fairly as possible on the basis of the many considerations, including sponsorship support, number of horses, past participation in this show optimum use and convenience, show décor, time of receipt of entries, ring use, number of classes entered and access considerations. We ask your cooperation in these assignments and once assignments have been made, please do not deviate without specific approval of the Barn Manager. Patron sponsors will have 1st priority over stable assignments. Exhibitors wishing to be stabled together should submit their entries in the same envelope. Please indicate on the entry form (stable with line) any special requests. Management will try to stable late entries as closely as possible to other entries, but there are no guarantees. Show management's decision is final.

**STABLING FACILITIES – LIMITED** – Each animal must be assigned to a separate stall (exception: broodmares with suckling foals). Horses must be placed in the stalls assigned. No changes permitted without express consent of the Barn Manager. Stalls will be available Wednesday May 17, 2017 and must be vacated no later than Sunday evening May 21, 2017. Exhibitors arriving prior to or departing later than these specified times should contact the Show Manager and make special arrangements and will be required to pay an additional daily fee of \$10 per stall per day. Portable stalls (canvas) with double doors will be \$120. Exhibitors may show from their trailers. Trailer fee is \$25 per horse. Every horse entered in this show, (except nursing foals with their dams) must pay either a stall or trailer fee – **NO EXCEPTIONS**. Exhibitors requesting special stall arrangements for being handicapped or disabled must have the blue State Handicap Card. Card number must be listed with the stall request. Stall decorations shall be made of non-flammable material or treated and maintained in a flame retardant condition. (Fire Marshall Sub-chapter 8) No nails, staples, screws or etc. are allowed in stalls. No straw allowed. Only manure and shavings may be put in the manure piles or left in the stalls. Please put all trash in the trashcans. Any exhibitor found in violation of this rule will be charged accordingly for repair and repainting.

**SUBSTITUTIONS** – Substitution of a horse may not be made after the announced closing date of entries. If a horse is sold or injured after closing of entries, exhibitor may post enter another in classes only.

**STALLIONS** – Stallions may be shown by ladies and junior exhibitors in any class except showmanship, walk/trot and lead line.

**MEDAL CLASSES** – Class specifications for Medal Classes are now in the USEF Rule Book.

**TBA CLASSES** – Any class on the AHA Class List (located on the AHA website) can be offered as a TBA class. **EXCEPTIONS:** Working Hunter, Team Penning, Ranch Sorting, Dressage, Jumper, Eventing, Combined Driving, Carriage Driving, Cutting, Reined Cow Horse, Working Cow Horse or any existing Championship classes will be held during the TBA time slots as noted in the schedule. Contact the show secretary if you would like to add a class. TBA Classes will be limited to TWO classes per entry and will be assigned on a FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED BASIS. The TBA classes are \$30 for a regular class or \$45 for a championship class. The TBA sponsor pays a sponsorship fee on top of the class fee (\$20/regular class; \$40/championship class). Anyone else entering that class only pays the class fee. No post entries.

**TWO-MINUTE GATE RULE** – Due to a full schedule of classes, the two-minute limit for gates will be strictly enforced. Exhibitors are cautioned against entering the same horse in successive classes. The gate will close two minutes after the first horse has entered the ring or in the case with large classes taking more than two minutes, as the final horse in a continuous string of horses. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that his/her horse is at the gate on time. Class calls must be considered a courtesy only. No protests will be upheld on the basis of a public address system malfunction.

**VETERINARIAN** – A veterinarian will be “ON CALL” only and NOT present during the show. All animals are subject to physical inspection by the Show Veterinarian at the discretion of the Show Committee.

**CRUELTY** – Cruelty to or the abuse of a horse by any person at a recognized show is forbidden. Excessive use of a whip on any horse in a stall, runway, schooling area, show ring, or elsewhere on the show grounds before or during a show, by any person, constitutes a violation and renders the offender subject to penalty. (See GR302)

**ADMISSION TO THE RING** – No person will be permitted to enter the ring except participants of the class, judges and their assistants and show officials. Attendants and grooms may enter the ring only when summoned by order of the judge.

**AGE OF HORSES** – For horse show purposes, any horse shall be considered to be one year old on the first day of January following the actual date of foaling. A Junior Horse is one that is 5 years old and under.

**AHA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT** – Each Competitor (this includes at least one recorded owner and all Trainers, Drivers, Riders, Halter Handlers, Coaches and the person(s) signing the entry blank) in an Arabian Horse Association Recognized Arabian Division, at the time of entry into a Competition, must submit a copy of a valid AHA Membership/Competition Card, join AHA or pay an AHA Single Event Membership Fee per Competitor. When an agent signs for the Owner at an AHA Recognized Competition, both the Owner and Agent must be members of AHA or pay the AHA Single Event Membership. Single Event Membership is not acceptable at AHA Regional or National Competitions. Exhibitors in Walk/Trot Classes are exempt from AHA Membership requirements at qualifying Competitions, but must have an AHA membership with competition card at AHA Regional and National Competitions. Exhibitors in Lead Line classes or parents/guardians signing for minors are exempt from AHA Membership requirements. (BOD 5/12)

**USEF MEMBERSHIP RULE** – Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular



**Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.**

#### **USEF AMATEUR CERTIFICATION**

1. Every person who has reached his/her 18th birthday and competes in classes for amateurs under Federation rules must possess current amateur certification issued by the Federation. This certification must be available for inspection or the competitor must have lodged with the competition secretary, at least one hour prior to such class, an application for such certification provided by the Federation. Certification will be issued only on receipt of the application properly signed and is revocable at any time for cause. Any person who has not reached his/her 18th birthday is an amateur and does not require amateur certification.
2. An amateur continues to be such until he/she has received a change in status from the Federation. Any amateur who wishes to be re-classified on the grounds that he/she has engaged or is planning on engaging in activities which would prevent him/her from continuing to remain an amateur must notify the Federation in writing.

**AMATEUR/OWNERS TO RIDE CLASSES** – An Owner's Class is one in which every contestant is an Amateur and the rider, handler or driver is the Owner or an Amateur Member of the owner's family (See GR106). Combined ownership is not permitted in Amateur/Owner classes unless all owners are members of the same family. Leased horses are not eligible for amateur owner to ride classes.

**CROSS ENTRIES – ARABIANS AND HALF-ARABIANS** – Cross-entries are prohibited between Country English Pleasure section and the English Pleasure section and the English Pleasure and Pleasure Driving sections and/or Informal/Combination classes at the same show. Cross-entries are prohibited between the Pleasure Driving sections and the Country Pleasure Driving and Country Pleasure sections and/or Country Pleasure Combination classes at the same show.

**DRUG AND MEDICATION** – All horses entered in the competition must be assessed a fee of \$16 (USEF) and \$5 (CDF) per horse to defray the expenses of the Drug testing. Horses in competition at a recognized competition are subject to examination by licensed veterinarian or appointed technician to perform certain duties under GR402.

**EXHIBITOR IDENTIFICATION NUMBERS** – Each horse entered in this show must be assigned an identification number for this show. Correct numbers must be worn by the riders and handlers in all classes.

**HACKAMORES AND SNAFFLES** – Hackamore (Bosal) and standard snaffles (As defined in Rule XVI, Article 1678.3) are permitted on ALL horses five years and under in all Western classes. Two hands may be used on Hackamore (Bosal) and Western snaffle reins.

**HALF-ARABIAN COLTS** – Half-Arabian Colts/Stallions, two years & older are excluded from all halter classes.

**HOOF RULE** – See rule AR103 in the USEF Rulebook

**INDEMNITY AND NON-RESPONSIBILITY CLAUSES** – All entries are accepted with the understanding that the Diablo Arabian Horse Association and the Brookside Show Park will not be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any horse exhibited, or any article of any kind. All horses shall be under the control and direction of the Show Committee but solely at the risk of the exhibitor, who will be responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any person, animal or property occasioned by him, his agents or employees, or by an animal owned or exhibited by him and shall indemnify Diablo Arabian Horse Association and the Brookside Show Park against any and all loss, damages and liability thus occasioned, including but not limited to any and all legal costs, including attorney fees, which may be incurred as a result thereof. The submitting of an entry form to the Show Secretary shall constitute an acceptance by each person signing same of the revisions herein set forth.

**INSURANCE ADVISORY** – Due to the number and quality of horses at this show we urge each exhibitor to verify their liability insurance coverage and their livestock mortality coverage with their own insurance carrier(s). Be sure your coverage is in effect. The Diablo Arabian Horse Association, its members, agents, employees and volunteers accept no responsibility for losses sustained or caused by any exhibitor.

**JUDGES** – If, for any reason, a judge fails to attend this show or perform his duties, the Show Committee reserves the right to substitute a judge for the one

who is officially designated in the Prize list. It is a violation of USEF Rules to commit any act or make remarks during the show that are considered offensive and/or made with the intent to influence or cast aspersions on the judging. No one shall approach a judge with regard to a decision or at any time unless he first obtains permission from the Show Committee or Steward who shall arrange an appointment with the Judge at a proper time and place.

**JUNIOR EXHIBITORS** – To be eligible, Riders must not have reached their 19th birthday as of December 1st of the current competition year. The age of an individual on December 1st will be maintained throughout the entire competition year. Persons born on December 1st assume the greater age on that date.

**SELECT RIDERS** – Refer to AHA Handbook Chapter 11 Comp 719 for Leveling Class Requirements and Achievement Leveling Points Program.

**NOVICE AND LIMIT HORSES/EXHIBITORS** – A Novice horse or exhibitor is one, which has not won three 1st place ribbons. A Limit horse or exhibitor is one, who has not won more than 6 1st place ribbons at a Recognized Show of the USEF. In the Arabian Division, ribbons won within a section shall not count in reckoning maiden/novice/limit status if the animal or exhibitor is transferred to a new classification (e.g. Arabian Park to Arabian Western Pleasure, etc.) at a Regular member Show of American Horse Shows Association or the Canadian Equestrian Federation. For purposes of this show, a maiden, novice or limit horse or exhibitor is as of the date of closing of entries.

**PADDOCK/WARM UP ARENAS** – There shall be no conduct in the paddock area, which disturbs or creates a hazard to horses or handlers/riders. There will be no whips, noisemakers or other equipment device or objects allowed in the paddock area, which may disturb or create a hazard to horses or handlers/riders. Exception: The show whip carried properly by a handler. Spectators in the paddock/warm-up arena are asked not be in either area during the show.

**PROTESTS** – Should any question or dispute arises, it must be protested in the same manner prescribed by USEF Rule GR603. A protest may be received by the Steward, Show Secretary, Show Manager or by a member of the Show Committee within 48 hours of the alleged violation.

**REFUSAL OF ENTRIES** – The management reserves the rights or to cancel any entries to any exhibitor, as stated in USEF GR1509.

**RULES** – The Horse Show is conducted in accordance with the rules of USEF, the Prize List and the show based on rules of the current USEF Rule Book and the AHA Handbook; any changes or corrections of rules will automatically become part of the Prize List. Each participant in this show is responsible for knowledge of and is subject to the USEF and AHA Rules. Every class offered herein which is covered by the Rules and Specification of the current USEF Rule Book and the AHA Handbook will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. Questions not covered by USEF and AHA Rules shall be decided by the Show Committee and its decision will be final.

**SCRATCHED CLASSES/RIDER/HANDLER CHANGES:** As a courtesy to the Gate Man, Announcer and Show Management, exhibitors are required to notify the Show Office when it is necessary to scratch a class or change a rider/handler. These scratches and changes should be made in the Show Office by 5:00 pm the night before the morning session or at least 1 hour prior to the start of the session involved. **EXCEPTION:** Scratches or handler changes in Sport Horse In Hand classes **MUST** be made in the show office no later than 5:00pm Saturday, May 20th. A fee of \$10 will be charged for non-notification of a scratched class or rider/handler change. **THIS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.**

**MOTORIZED VEHICLES** – Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for the child committing the offense. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion for the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

**VACCINATIONS** – Horses coming to the Diablo Arabian Spring Horse Show will be required to have Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhino pneumonitis) vaccinations within six months. Horse entering from outside the state will also need a health certificate in addition to the Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhino pneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the show grounds. Personnel will be on-site checking for paperwork. Owners and trainers will need a copy of the paperwork with them in the barn and a copy must be submitted to the show office prior to back numbers being released.

**Membership Requirements for USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized Competitions:** Owners and riders, including foreign riders and owners who are not residents of the US, wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition as a rider or owner/lessee, must have either a USDF Group Membership, Participating Membership (PM), or have a USDF Non-Member (NM) identification number and pay the USDF NM fee. (Note: USDF business members can own horses but cannot compete as riders with their USDF BM.) Individuals cannot compete at a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition with a USDF Education Membership.

Horses competing at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions must have either a USDF Horse Identification (HID) number or a USDF Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR). Proper credentials or verification certificates must be presented to the competition secretary.

Riders and owners wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition, and not able to present the competition secretary with verification of a USDF membership or NM identification, and USDF LHR or USDF HID, must complete a USDF Competition Affidavit Form and pay the \$5 affidavit filing fee. A copy of a completed affidavit form from another competition may also be used for verification purposes for up to 60 days. (Exception: Affidavits cannot be used at Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championships.)

**Exceptions:**

- Horses competing only in Individual Breed Classes (IBCs) at DSHB competitions, sires and dams of horses in DSHB group classes, where those sires or dams are not actually competing in the same competition, horses competing only in breed restricted dressage or DSHB classes at Regular Competitions (e.g. all Arabian, all Friesian, or all Morgan classes), or in USDF Introductory Level tests, pas de deux, quadrille, FEI Para-Equestrian classes, are exempt from this requirement. Also exempt are horses ridden in leadline, exhibitions, games and races, classes for 4-H members, walk-trot, academy and opportunity classes.
- Riders and owners/lessees competing only in classes which are exempt from the USDF HID requirements are also exempt from the USDF NM identification number and NM fee requirements. Also exempt are handlers of horses competing in DSHB In-Hand or Group classes.

**Memberships Defined**

**Participating Membership (PM):** A membership issued to an individual directly by USDF. The membership year is December 1 through November 30. PMs are available for 1-year (\$75), 5-years (\$300), or life (\$1,500). A USDF Youth Participating Membership (YPM) is available for individuals who have not reached their 21<sup>st</sup> birthday by December 1 of the current membership year (\$60). A PM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and to participate as a rider and/or owner/lessee for all Adequan®/USDF Year-End Awards, Great American Insurance Group/USDF Breeders Championship Series Finals and the Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championship program.

**Group Membership (GM):** A membership issued to an individual by USDF when the member name and dues are submitted to USDF through an affiliate Group Member Organization (GMO). The GM year begins December 1 and ends November 30. A GM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and participate in the USDF Rider Awards program.

**Business Membership (BM):** A membership that runs December 1 through November 30 and is issued to a business or organization directly by USDF. The USDF BM (\$200) offers a wider variety of advertising benefits. BMs satisfy requirements of horse ownership only.

**Education Membership (EM):** A membership issued to an individual directly by USDF. This online education only membership expires 12 months after the date joined. This membership type does NOT allow an individual to compete at a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition.

**Non-Member (NM) Identification Number:** For each USDF NM owner/lessee and USDF NM rider there will be a USDF NM fee of \$25 per competition that must be collected by the show secretary and submitted to USDF, along with the USDF Report of Fees document and the \$5 affidavit fee and Competition Affidavit Form if the person cannot provide a copy of their USDF NM card. Owners/lessees or riders exempt from the NM number requirements are also exempt from paying the USDF NM fee. If there are multiple owners of a horse and all are NMs, only one of the owners must pay the NM fee. If the horse has at least one owner who is a current USDF PM, GM, or BM there is no NM fee assessed. Competition management will be invoiced for all applicable USDF NM fees not received with the USDF post competition paperwork, along with a report listing all USDF NMs. Competition management is then required to submit the NM fees within 30 days to the USDF. An individual with a USDF NM identification number is not eligible for any USDF membership benefits. Once a USDF NM number has been assigned, a USDF NM card can be obtained from the USDF website.

**Horse Identification (HID) Number:** A one-time tracking number for horses (\$25). Scores earned by a horse with an HID number will be recorded, but will NOT be counted towards Adequan®/USDF Year-End Awards. A horse with an HID number is not eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying or championship classes or Great American Insurance Group/USDF Breeders Championship Series Finals. An HID number can be upgraded to a Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) for a fee of \$70. If a horse has a USDF LHR it does not need an HID number. An HID number is a one-time fee that does not need to be renewed.

**Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR):** A horse with an LHR (\$95) is eligible for Adequan®/USDF Year-End Awards, and eligible to compete at Great American Insurance Group/USDF Breeders Championship Series Finals and Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying and championship classes, assuming requirements for the owner and rider are met. If a horse has an LHR it does not need an HID number. An LHR does not need to be renewed.

**How to Join USDF**

Applications for USDF Participating Membership (PM), Business Membership (BM), Horse Identification (HID) number, and Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) may be found in the following locations:

The effective date of membership is the date the form and correct fees are received in the USDF office or, if applying at a competition, the date accepted by the competition secretary, provided the application is signed and dated by the competition secretary, member, and/or horse owner on that same day.
